

ASH WEDNESDAY February 18th

The season of Lent is a Catholic liturgical season consisting of 40 days of fasting, prayer and penance beginning on Ash Wednesday. The official liturgical colour is violet. It is a sacred time in the Church to prepare our hearts for Easter. It is a season of prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and spiritual renewal, helping us reflect on Christ's sacrifice and grow closer to God. **For Lent 2026**, Pope Leo XIV focuses on prayer, penance, and reflection, with key intentions for February dedicated to children with incurable diseases.

TEMPERANCE SUNDAY

DAY OF PRAYER 15TH FEBRUARY

A day which offers us an opportunity to reflect on our relationship with alcohol and a day on which we can take time to pray for those who suffer from addiction. The Apostle of Temperance Father Mathew (1790-1856) was a Capuchin friar from Tipperary whose 19th Century crusade against the abuse of alcohol gained him the title of "Apostle of Temperance". Father Mathew's call to sobriety has relevance to modern Ireland. The cost to the nation by way of, human suffering, abstention from work, criminality and social upheaval is inestimable.

Prayer: Compassionate Lord and Saviour, you inspired the Capuchin Friar Theobold Mathew to show your compassionate face to those addicted and burdened by the abuse of alcohol or addicted behaviour, and to promote temperance. May we today, continue to serve our brothers and sisters with love and joy, and to foster balance, and moderation in our life styles with the help of God. So, we pray, "here goes in the name of God." Amen

THE HOOK OF FAITH

The Sunday before Lent is known as 'Temperance Sunday'. In the light of God's Word for this Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time, we explore the meaning of temperance, its value and the dangers of excess. The First Friday of Lent is dedicated annually as a 'Day of Prayer for Victims of Abuse'. We have resources and reflections to mark this important day of atonement and healing. We have the last episode of the series 'The Desert Fathers in a Year' and a look back on 'World Day of the Sick' with Bishop Michael Router. At a time when the topic of mental health is discussed, a video interview clarifies a Catholic understanding of how we can become and stay mentally healthy. Another video reflects on the enduring value of Catholic Education and new research into the plight of loneliness in the UK. Finally, a new resource is now available from the Irish Bishops based on the document 'Baptised and Sent' which invites all of us to live our baptismal call more deeply this Lent and as we prepare for Easter.
