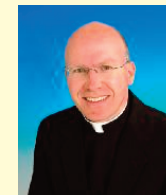
Dear Parishioners,

If you are interested in helping in any of these areas, please indicate in the box, and leave your name and contact details into the parish office and we will be in touch with you.

Running the parish of St. Aidan's involves a large expense on building maintenance, insurance, staff wages, heating, lighting and a variety of other costs. Statements of our annual accounts are displayed on the church notice board and copies may be obtained from the parish office. All funds raised to run the parish and pay our contributions to Ferns Diocesan expenses are raised locally only in the following ways:

- Sunday Envelope Collection:** this is our main source of funding. These may be obtained from the parish office and once your name is included, you will receive your box of envelopes in December each year.
- Voluntary Fundraising:** funding is raised by parishioners voluntarily participating in parish events such as our annual Golf Classic, Silver Circle Draws, Tax Rebate Scheme etc.
- Once Off Annual Contribution:** you could make an annual contribution by cash or cheque directly to the parish office. A receipt will always be issued. Cheques should be made payable to "St. Aidan's Parish".
- Remember us in your Will:** The good you have done in your life can continue after your death. You could insert the following wording in your will – **"I give and bequeath to The Administrator for the time being of St. Aidan's Parish, Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford the sum of €_____ for the general purposes, upkeep of the said parish and adornment of the Cathedral. The receipt of this said Administrator will be sufficient evidence of the payment of such sum"**.
- Standing Order:** An alternative to the weekly envelope collection is for you to set up a standing order payment directly to the parish. If this is a suitable option for you, please complete the standing order below and return it to the parish office.
