Organ Facts Continued...

In 1981 further work was carried out on the organ with the contract being awarded to The Irish Organ Company which were based in Belfast and Dublin. The entire organ was removed from the gallery and sent to Belfast for remodeling and refurbishment. The work was completed in March 1983 at a cost of £22,450. In March 1983, the two manual console was installed in front of the altar at a cost of £2,750 and two-thirds of the gallery organ was playable from here. This also allowed cantors to sing from the ambo. (Adrian Doyle)



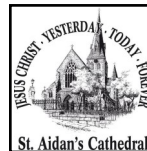

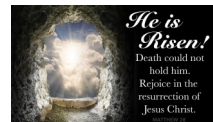
